On September 17, 2020, the Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions (the "Department") issued a Notice of Hearing ("Notice") in the above-captioned matter, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit A** and incorporated by this reference. The Notice required Tiffany Gillies ("Respondent") to provide a written answer to the allegations set forth in the Notice within twenty days of the issuance of the Notice. As of this date, Respondent has failed to file an answer. On October 14, 2020, counsel for the Department filed a Motion for Default, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit B**. As of this date, Respondent has not responded to the Department's motion. Pursuant to A.A.C.R20-6-106(D), a party that fails to file an answer within the time provided shall be deemed to be in default and one or more of the allegations in the Notice of Hearing may be deemed to be admitted.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- Notice was proper.
- 2. Respondent is in default.

3. The allegations in the Notice are deemed admitted.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The conduct alleged in the Notice constitutes grounds for the Director to

The allegations supporting this Notice of Hearing are as follows:

1. Tiffany Gillies ("Gillies" or "Respondent") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona non-resident insurance producer with lines of authority in property and casualty insurance, National Producer Number 19271818. Respondent's license is scheduled to expire on August 31, 2023.

- 2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: 888 S. 2000 E., Clearfield, UT 84015 (business); 1868 W. 300 N., Clearfield, UT 84015 (mailing) and tiffany.gillies@utah.aaa.com (business e-mail).
- 3. On August 29, 2019, Respondent submitted an application for an Arizona non-resident insurance producer license ("Application") to the Department.
- 4. In the Application, under Background Questions, Respondent answered "No" to the following question:
 - 1B. "Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony? You may exclude juvenile adjudications (offenses where you were adjudicated delinquent in a juvenile court)".
- 5. On September 16, 2019, the Department issued to Respondent an Arizona non-resident insurance producer license.
- 6. The Federal Bureau of Investigations conducted a criminal history check of Respondent's fingerprint card and notified the Department that Respondent had the following convictions:
- a. On April 6, 2005, the State of Utah District Court, 4th District Heber
 City, convicted Respondent of a Class 3 Felony for Illegal Possession of Controlled
 Substance, case number 041500008.
- b. On July 28, 2008, the State of Utah District Court, 2nd District Farmington City, convicted Respondent of a Class 3 Felony for Illegal Possession/Use of Controlled Substance, case number 081700074.

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7. Respondent answered "Yes" to the Attestation section of the Application.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue information in the license application, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).
- 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes having been convicted of a felony, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(6).
- 4. Grounds exist for the Director to deny, suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's Arizona non-resident insurance producer's license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).

WHEREFORE, if after hearing, the Director finds the grounds alleged above, the Director may deny, suspend, or revoke Respondent's Arizona non-resident insurance producer's license. A.R.S. § 20-295(A).

The Director delegates the authority vested in him to the Director of the Office of Administrative Hearings or his designee to preside over the hearing of this matter as the Administrative Law Judge, to make written recommendations to the Director consisting of proposed findings of fact, proposed conclusions of law, and a proposed order. This delegation does not include delegation of the authority of the Director to make an order on the hearing or any other final decision in this matter. A.R.S. § 20-150.
