CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions ("Department") has received evidence that Vernon Lee Smith ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S"). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Finding of Fact are true, and consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident insurance producer with lines of authority in property and casualty insurance, National Producer Number 11518393. Respondent's license is scheduled to expire on June 30, 2022.
- 2. Respondent's business and mailing address of record with the Department is 11821 N. 28th Drive, Apt. L289, Phoenix, AZ, 85029. Respondent's business e-mail address of record with the Department is vsmithenterprises a outlook.com.
- 3. On April 15, 2019, Respondent submitted an application for an Arizona insurance producer license ("Application") to the Department.
- In the Application, under Background Questions, Respondent answered "No" 4. to the following question:

- 1B. "Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony? You may exclude juvenile adjudications (offenses where you were adjudicated delinquent in a juvenile court)."
- 5. Respondent answered "Yes" to the Attestation section of the Application.
- 6. On April 17, 2019, the Department issued an insurance producer license to Respondent.
- 7. The Federal Bureau of Investigations conducted a criminal history check of Respondent's fingerprint card and notified the Department that Respondent had the following conviction:

On or after July 20, 1999, a California Court convicted Respondent of burglary.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director of the Department ("Director") has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue information in the license application, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).
- 3. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend for not more than twelve months or revoke Respondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A).
- 4. Grounds exist, in addition to or instead of any suspension or revocation, for the Director to impose a civil penalty of not more than \$250.00 dollars for each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of \$2,500.00, or impose a civil penalty of

not more than \$2,500.00 for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil 2 penalty of \$15,000.00, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(F). 3 **ORDER** 4 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT: 5 1. Respondent shall immediately pay to the Department a civil money penalty of 6 two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) for deposit into the State General Fund. Respondent has reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law 13 and Order. 14 2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Director of the Arizona 15 Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact 16 and consents to the entry of the foregoing Conclusions of Law and Order. 17 3. Respondent is aware of his right to notice and to a hearing, at which he may be 18 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. 19 4. Respondent irrevocably waives his right to such notice and hearing and to any 20 court appeals relating to this Consent Order. 21 22

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- 5. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to induce him to enter into this Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.
- 6. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against his and does not preclude any other agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.
- 7. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on any license application.
