CONSENT ORDER

The Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that
Jack Dominic Mafara JR. ("Mafara" or "Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20,
Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S"). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the
commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Finding of Fact are true,
and consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Mafara first obtained his insurance producer license in 2001. His license,
 national producer number 5717944, was last renewed on April 1, 2019, and is scheduled to
 expire on March 31, 2023.

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2. Mafara is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident
17 insurance producer with a line of authority in life insurance.

 East West Financial, 1475 Palma Road, Bullhead City, Arizona 86442. Mafara's business e mail address of record with the Department is <u>jack@eastwestfinancialservicesllc.com</u>.

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1	Failure to Report	
2	4. On January 30, 2019, The State Bar of Arizona ("The State Bar") issued a	
3	Cease and Desist Order against Mafara for engaging in the unauthorized practice of law in	
4	Arizona.	
5	5. Mafara failed to notify the Director of this administrative action within thirty	
6	(30) days after final disposition of this matter.	
7	Unlicensed Business Entity	
8	6. On February 21, 2008, East West Financial Services I LLC ("East West") was	
9	registered as a business entity with the Arizona Corporation Commission. Mafara is listed as	
10	the manager for East West. On November 18, 2019, a Department investigation revealed that	
11	Mafara was marketing insurance business through East West.	
12	7. Mafara failed to obtain a business entity insurance producer license for East	
13	West prior to engaging in activities that require an Arizona insurance license.	
14	8. On January 31, 2020, the Department conducted an Examination Under Oath	
-15	of Mafara and addressed his failure to obtain a business entity insurance producer license for	
16	East West. The Department instructed Mafara to immediately report the administrative	
17	action taken by The State Bar and also to obtain a business entity insurance producer license	
18	for East West if he wishes to conduct insurance business through this entity.	
19	9. On March 12, 2020, the Department conducted a subsequent investigation to	
20	ensure Mafara's compliance following the examination. The investigation revealed that	
21	Mafara failed to notify the Department of the State Bar administrative action and also failed	
22	to obtain a business entity insurance producer license for East West while continuing to	
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1 || conduct insurance business through the entity.

2 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW** 3 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of Title 20 or 4 2. any rule, subpoena or order of the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2). 5 3. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failure to notify the 6 director within thirty days after the final disposition of the matter of any administrative 7 action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction, in violation of A.R.S. § 20-301(A). 8 Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failing to apply for a 9 4. business entity license, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(C). 10 Grounds exist for the Director to suspend for not more than twelve months or 5. 11 12 revoke Respondent's insurance producer license, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(A). Grounds exist, in addition to or instead of any suspension or revocation, for the 6. 13 Director to impose a civil penalty of not more than \$250.00 dollars for each unintentional 14 failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of \$2,500.00, or impose a civil penalty of 15 not more than \$2,500.00 for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil 16 penalty of \$15,000.00, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(F). 17 18 19 20111 21 /// 22 /// 22

4	a civil penalty of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for deposit into the State General Fund.

19	court appeals relating to this Consent Order.
20	5. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
21	expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to induce him to enter into this Consent
22	Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.
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1 6. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the 2 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency, 3 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal 4 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter. 5 7. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action 6 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners 7 (NAIC).
