ORDER SUMMARILY SUSPENDING CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY AND NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

Respondent.

The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that **Time Insurance Company ("Respondent")** has violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent is domiciled in the State of Wisconsin and presently holds a certificate of authority issued by the Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions ("Department") to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona.
- 2. Respondent's continued operation of insurance business in the State of Arizona is deemed to be hazardous to its policyholders, creditors and/or the general public for the following reasons:
 - a. On May 18, 2020, the Wisconsin Commissioner of Insurance filed with the Circuit Court of the Dane County, Wisconsin, a Notice of Verified Petition and Verified Petition for Order for Rehabilitation against Respondent.

- b. On July 29, 2020, the Circuit Court of the Dane County entered against Respondent an Order for Rehabilitation. The Order for Rehabilitation appointed the Commissioner, Mark Afable, and his successor in office, as a Rehabilitator of Respondent.
- c. Respondent's December 31, 2020, Annual Financial Statement filed with the Department revealed a **negative** SAP surplus balance in the amount of six million nine hundred fiftynine thousand three hundred ninety-seven dollars (\$6,959,397.00).
- d. Respondent failed to meet the statutory required minimum surplus of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00).
- 3. In light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 41-1092.11(B).

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. Respondent failed to maintain minimum required surplus, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-210.
- 2. Respondent's capital is deemed impaired, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-611(8).
- 3. Respondent's continued operation of insurance business in this state is deemed to be hazardous to its policyholders or creditors or the general public pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-220.01(A)(1).
- 4. Respondent is in unsound financial condition or in such condition as to render its further transaction of insurance in this state hazardous to the policyholders or to the people of the State of Arizona, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-220(A)(3).
- 5. The Director shall suspend or revoke the certificate of authority of any insurer which no longer meets the requirements for the authority originally granted, on account of deficiency in assets or otherwise, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-219(2).

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED summarily suspending the Arizona certificate of authority held by Time Insurance Company and, effective immediately, prohibiting the issuance of new and renewal Arizona insurance policies.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

You have the right to request a hearing on this determination by filing a notice of appeal after your receipt of this notice. The notice of appeal must identify the party appealing, the party's address, the matter being appealed and must contain a detailed statement of the reason for the appeal. Your hearing will be treated as a "contested case" and promptly instituted and determined as prescribed by A.R.S. §§ 41-1092(43), 41-1092.05(E) and 41-1092.11(B) to the extent the Office of Administrative Hearings' calendar permits. In any event, your hearing will be held within 60 days of the filing of your notice of appeal, unless the hearing is advanced or delayed by agreement or a showing of good cause by any party. The Department will serve a "Notice of Hearing" in accordance with A.R.S. § 41-1092.05(D) that will inform you of the date, time and location of the hearing as well as the issues to be determined.

If you file an appeal, you may also request an "informal settlement conference" pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.06 by filing a written request no more than twenty (20) days before the scheduled hearing. The conference will be held within 15 days after our receipt of your request. If an informal

1 settlement conference is requested, a person with the authority to act on behalf of the Department will 2 be present.
