8 this Order by the Director of Insurance, State of Arizona, is
9 solely for the purpose of settling this matter against them and
10 does not preclude any other agency or officer of this state or
11 subdivision thereof from instituting civil or criminal
12 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.


13 6. Robert Chrysler Morgan represents that he is the
