On March 12, 1996, the Office of Administrative Hearings, through Administrative Law Judge Lewis D. Kowal submitted "Recommended Order Approving Merger and Transfer of Statutory Deposit", a copy of which is attached and incorporated by this reference. The Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance has reviewed the recommendation, and enters the following order:

- The recommended findings of fact and conclusions 1. of law are adopted.
- The Flan and Agreement of Merger between the Insurer and the Petitions is approved.
- The statutory deposit of the Insurer in the amount 3. of \$200,000.00 will be transferred into a statutory deposit account in the name of the Petitioner upon receipt by the Department of the following: (1) payment of examination expenses; (2) copies of the Articles of Merger of the Insurer and

the Petitioner certified as filed by the Arizona Corporation Commission; and (3) fully executed Forms E125 and E126. The statutory deposit will not be transferred until the Department receives a fully executed copy of the official State Treasurer Release Receipt.

- 4. The Petitioner will promptly remit to the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") payment for expenses incurred as a result of this merger.
- 5. The sum of \$100.00 previously credited to the IERF will be refunded to the Insurer pursuant to A.R.S. §20-159.
- 6. The Insurer will file a 1996 Annual Statement with the Department, together with all applicable fees, unless the Insurer files its Plan of Merger pursuant to A.R.S. §10-1105 with the Arizona Corporation Commission before December 31, 1996 and returns a file-stamped copy to the Department.
- 7. The Insurer will file with the Department a 1995
 Annual Statement together with all applicable fees and a copy of
 the Articles of Merger having a stamped file date of March 31,
 1996 or a prior date of filing with the Arizona Corporation
 Commission or the Insurer will be responsible for any certificate
 of authority renewal fee.

NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

The aggrieved party may request a rehearing with respect to this Order by filing a written petition with the Office of Administrative Hearings within 30 days of the date of this Order, setting forth the basis for such relief pursuant to A.A.C. R20-6-114(B).

The final decision of the Director may be appealed to the Superior Court of Maricopa County for judicial review pursuant to A.R.S. §20-166.

RECOMMENDED ORDER APPROVING MERGER AND TRANSFER OF STATUTORY **DEPOSIT**

On March 11, 1996, a hearing was held at the Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") at 2910 North 44th Street, Suite 210, Phoenix, Arizona to consider the Plan and Agreement of Merger whereby Lenders Life

Insurance Company (the "Insurer"), NAIC No. 93939, will merge into Pittsburgh National Life Insurance Company (the "Petitioner"), NAIC No. 89923.

Based upon the entire record in this matter, including all pleadings, motions, testimony and exhibits admitted during the hearing of this matter, Administrative Law Judge Lewis D. Kowal has prepared the following Recommended Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Proposed Order for consideration by the Director of the Department ("Director"):

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- Insurer is duly qualified and authorized as a life and disability 1. reinsurer in the State of Arizona.
- Petitioner is duly qualified and authorized as a life and disability reinsurer in the State of Arizona.
- Both the Insurer and the Petitioner have waived the twenty-five (25) 3. day notice requirement of A.R.S. §20-731(C).
- 4. The shareholder of the Insurer and the shareholder of the Petitioner have waived the notice of the hearing of this matter.

- 5. No evidence has been produced at the hearing of this matter that would indicate or form the basis for a finding that the Plan and Agreement of Merger previously filed:
 - a. Is contrary to law.
- b. Is unfair in the terms and conditions of the issuance and exchange of securities.
- c. Would substantially reduce the security of and service to be rendered to policyholders of the domestic insurer in this State or elsewhere.
- 7. The Insurer has surrendered its Certificate of Authority to the Department.
- 8. The Department's review of Petitioner's filing indicated that the provisions of A.R.S. §20-731 have been satisfied and recommended that the Director approve the Plan and Agreement of Merger filed in this matter.
- 9. The Department may have incurred examination expenses as a result of this merger.
- 10. The Petitioner has requested that the \$200,000.00 statutory deposit held by the State Treasurer in the name of the Insurer be transferred into a statutory deposit account in the name of the Petitioner.

RECOMMENDED ORDER

The undersigned Administrative Law Judge recommends that:

- 1. The Plan and Agreement of Merger between the Insurer and the Petitioner be approved.
- 2. The statutory deposit of the Insurer in the amount of \$200,000.00 be transferred into a statutory deposit account in the name of the Petitioner upon receipt by the Department of the following: (1) payment of examination expenses; (2) copies of the Articles of Merger of the Insurer and the Petitioner certified as filed by the Arizona Corporation Commission; and (3) fully executed Forms E125 and E126. The statutory deposit not be transferred until the Department receives a fully executed copy of the official State Treasurer Release Receipt.
- 3. The Petitioner promptly remit to the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") payment for expenses incurred as a result of this merger.
- 4. The sum of \$100.00 previously credited to the IERF be refunded to the Insurer pursuant to A.R.S. §20-159.

- 5. The Insurer file a 1996 Annual Statement with the Department, together with all applicable fees, unless the Insurer files its Plan of Merger pursuant to A.R.S. §10-1105 with the Arizona Corporation Commission before December 31, 1996 and returns a file-stamped copy to the Department.
- 6. The Insurer file with the Department a 1995 Annual Statement together with all applicable fees and a copy of the Articles of Merger having a stamped file date of March 31, 1996 or a prior date of filing with the Arizona Corporation Commission or the Insurer be responsible for any certificate of authority renewal fee.
